
How to Vote by Mail for Virginia University Students

- 1. Register to Vote:
 - Ensure you are registered to vote in Virginia. You can check your registration status or register online at the <u>Virginia Department of Elections</u> website:



When you register, you should receive confirmation of registration within two weeks. If you don't receive it, contact the Virginia Department of Elections.

- 2. Request an Absentee Ballot Once Registration is Confirmed. Visit the Virginia Department of Elections absentee ballot request page and complete the online request form.
 - You must request your absentee ballot by 5 PM on October 24th, 2025.
 - You will be asked what address you prefer to receive your ballot: home or another location (it CANNOT be a PO Box).

Receive Your Ballot:

- Once your request is processed, you will receive your absentee ballot in the mail. Mail-in Ballots are sent out on the first day of early voting. If your ballot is not received in a timely manner, contact the Department of Elections. Ballots can be mailed starting 45 days prior to the election date.
- Fully read the instructions provided with your ballot and follow them precisely. There will be multiple envelopes.

 Mark your choices on the ballot using a black or blue pen. Make sure to fill in the ovals completely.

4. Prepare Your Ballot for Mailing:

- Place your completed ballot in the return envelope provided.
- In order for your ballot to be counted, you MUST provide all requested information on the envelope, including your signature.
- Check it over for accuracy and then seal.

5. Mail Your Ballot:

- Mail your ballot as soon as possible to ensure it is postmarked by Election Day and received by the deadline.
- You can use a drop box or take your ballot into the local election office only where you are registered, otherwise it must be mailed.
- Track Your Ballot: You can track the status of your absentee ballot on the Virginia Department of Elections <u>Citizen Portal</u>.
- If you change your mind and decide to vote in person, contact the Virginia Department of Elections. You will need to return your mail-in ballot and envelopes.
